

Eurekaweek 2021: How to get access?

- Use this tool to know how to get access to the Eurekaweek 2021.
- No rights can be derived from this tool! All information is subject to change. It is your own responsibility to obtain a valid document.
- Please note: the CoronaCheck will be done upon entry at each event, and not just at the beginning of the week. Your documents must always be up to date.
 - Test: max. 24h old.
 - Vaccination: min. 2 weeks (Pfizer/Moderna/AstraZeneca) or 4 weeks (Janssen) old.
 - Recovery: max. 180 days old

You need to get tested.

- You need to get tested at a Testen voor Toegang location.
 - These tests can be booked for free at <https://www.testenvoortoegang.org/>
 - Book your tests in advance.
 - Do not get tested at Testen voor Toegang if you have symptoms that might indicate Corona! In those cases, get tested at the GGD (call 0800-1202).
- Your test result is valid for 24 hours.
 - This means that at the moment you are entering a Eureka week event at which the CoronaCheck app is used, your result must be less than 24h old.
- You do not need a DigiD to add your test result to the CoronaCheck app.
